1 Residence Hall Association 2 NWM001F 2021 3 November 16, 2021 4 5 A Resolution to Encourage Wearing Masks on Public Transportation 6 7 WHEREAS the Residence Hall Association (RHA) is the governing body for all on-campus 8 students at the University of Maryland (UMD), and 9 10 WHEREAS the Department of Transportation Services (DOTS) operates as UMD's primary mechanism for the transport of students throughout the greater College Park area, and 11 12 13 WHEREAS UMD has required every student to be vaccinated against COVID-19 save for 14 religious and medical exemptions, resulting in a 98% vaccination rate (Addendum A), and 15 16 WHEREAS the campus' high vaccination rate may confer to students a false sense of immunity 17 against COVID-19 infection, and 18 19 WHEREAS COVID-19 has mutated into variants that are more likely to be carried by vaccinated 20 individuals (Addendum B), and 21 22 WHEREAS a study by the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences has found masks to 23 be 79% effective in protecting against COVID-19 infections, stating that "face mask use could 24 result in a large reduction in risk of infection" (Addendum C), and 25 26 WHEREAS UMD and DOTS' shuttle bus system follow Prince George's County's indoor mask 27 mandate that is tentatively in place until Thursday, Dec. 9, 2021, given its geographic location in 28 the jurisdiction (Addendum D), and 29 30 WHEREAS buses are considered an indoor environment, and 31 32 WHEREAS these buses are driven by paid DOTS employees, and 33 34 WHEREAS drivers and passengers are often subjected to unsafe conditions due to mask 35 mandate non-compliant bus-riders according to DOTS, and 36 37 WHEREAS UMD has shown no sign of lifting the mask mandate despite its high vaccination 38 rate due to new variants and cases continuing to spike across the nation, and 39 40 WHEREAS students habitually board shuttle buses without a mask on, and risk exposing others 41 exposing others to the virus if they are an asymptomatic COVID-19 carrier, and 42

43	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that RHA fully support and encourage the continued	
44	wearing of masks when using campus transportation until the Centers for Disease Control	
45	declares COVID-19 as an endemic and UMD has lifted mask restrictions for the vaccinated	
46	(Addendum E).
